

The Port of Longview is seeking a Project Engineer.

POSITION: The Project Engineer's primary duty is developing and leading a project from initial concept, through the design process to implementation, with specific emphasis on the engineering design, analysis and management of the Port's maintenance, capital improvement and public works projects. This includes preparing engineering documents such as design drawings, specifications, material takeoffs, estimates, permit applications and balancing multiple projects against resource availability. Responsibilities will include coordination and supervision of consultants, contractors and identified Port Labor working on various projects. This position also provides in-house engineering services to the Planning and Environmental, Business Development and Marine Terminals departments.

EXPERIENCE AND EDUCATION: This position generally requires a bachelor's degree in engineering from an accredited college or university or a minimum of seven years of experience with a background in engineering, construction management, project management or other related fields. Previous construction experience is required; rail experience is preferred. This position requires a Professional Engineering license or the ability to acquire one within a year.
