

Proposed Rule or Policy Changes

Washington Wildlife and Recreation Program Match Waiver

The Recreation and Conservation Funding Board is proposing changes to policies that will affect the Washington Wildlife and Recreation Program's Local Parks, Trails, and Water Access Categories. The board is seeking comments on four policy proposals providing four unique "pathways" many local governments (cities, towns, counties, tribes, special purpose districts) to provide less than the current 50 percent minimum required match.
